Virtuoso flutist Janet Ketchum blends superb technique, dazzling repertoire, and unique program combinations with a spirited love for music to thrill audiences from London to Fairbanks. Among her various performances, she premiered the Nielsen Flute Concerto with the Philadelphia Orchestra, toured twenty-nine Alaskan communities for the Alaskan Council on the Arts, and performed on the Oscarwinning soundtracks "Aladdin" and "Out of Africa". She has played recitals at London's Wigmore Hall and Carnegie Recital Hall. She was named a distinguished young artist by Musical America and High Fidelity Magazine. Janet is a graduate of the Curtis Institute of Musical and has played principal flute with the San Francisco Ballet, Ojai Musical Festival, and guest principal with the Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra.

Mario Guarneri performed as principal trumpet with the Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra and the Los Angeles Opera Orchestra for ten seasons. He has performed with the Los Angeles Philharmonic, the New York Philharmonic, the Los Angeles Brass Quintet, and the San Francisco Opera Orchestra, among other orchestras and ensembles. In addition to solo appearances, he also performs with his own jazz quartet and has done studio work in television, recordings, and motion pictures, performing as the trumpet soloist on the soundtrack for Godfather III. A member of the faculty of the San Francisco Conservatory, he has also been on the faculty at Music Academy of the West and UCLA. He has recorded for Crystal Records and Nonesuch Records. He has a BM from USC and MM from the Julliard School.

Paul Asimow, who is making his sixth conducting appearance with the Caltech-Occidental Concert Band, is a Caltech graduate student in geology. Paul was born in Los Angeles. He did his undergraduate work at Harvard University, where he was director of the school's marching ensemble, the Harvard University Band.

William Bing, the director of Caltech's Jazz Bands, has been teaching at Caltech since 1971. In addition to his duties at Caltech, Bill plays and teaches trumpet in the Los Angeles area. For the last two years, he has been a guest artist with Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra. He has also performed with such varied artists as Jack Benny and Lou Rawls. One of his proudest moments came last year when Bill and his wife Delores, who is in charge of Caltech's Chamber Music Program, received the 16th Annual "Excellence in Teaching Award" from the Associated Students of Caltech. This year, Bill and Delores are the recipients of Annual Music Educators Award given by the Pasadena Area Youth Music Council.
